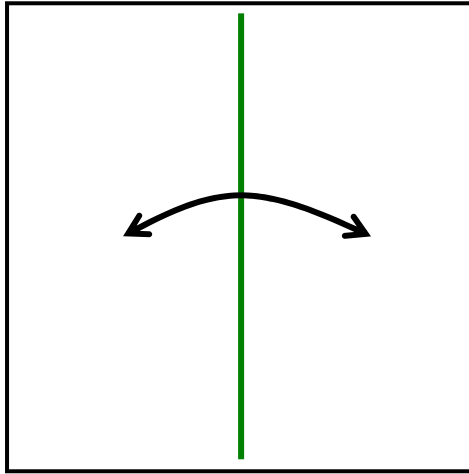
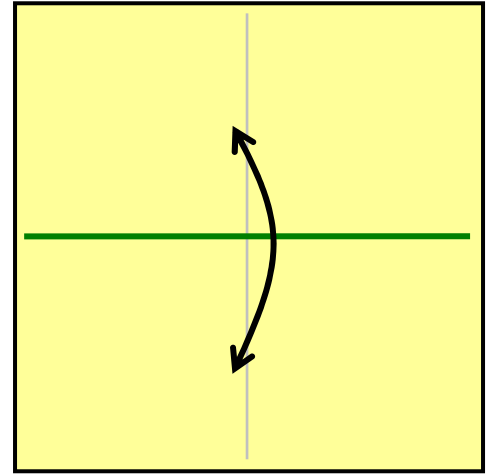


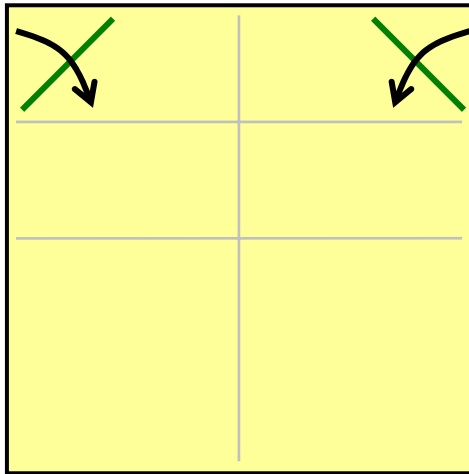
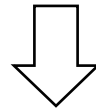
Folding the Sabre-sharp in 9 easy steps.



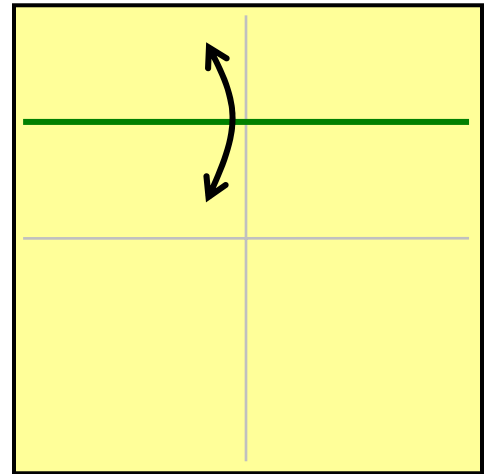
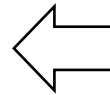
Fold a **square** paper vertically in half on the white side and unfold. Then turn the sheet around



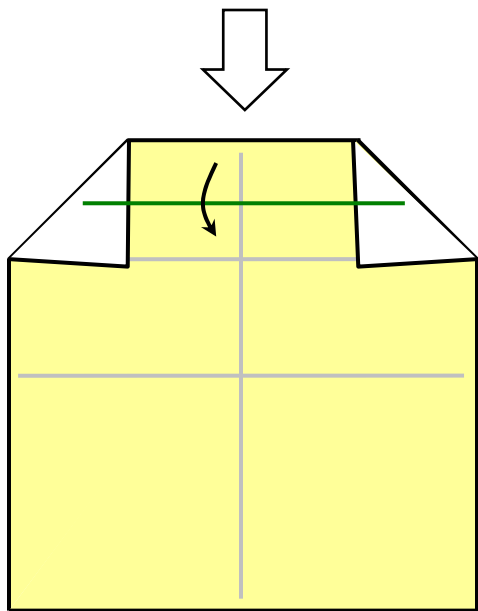
Fold the paper horizontally into half and then unfold.



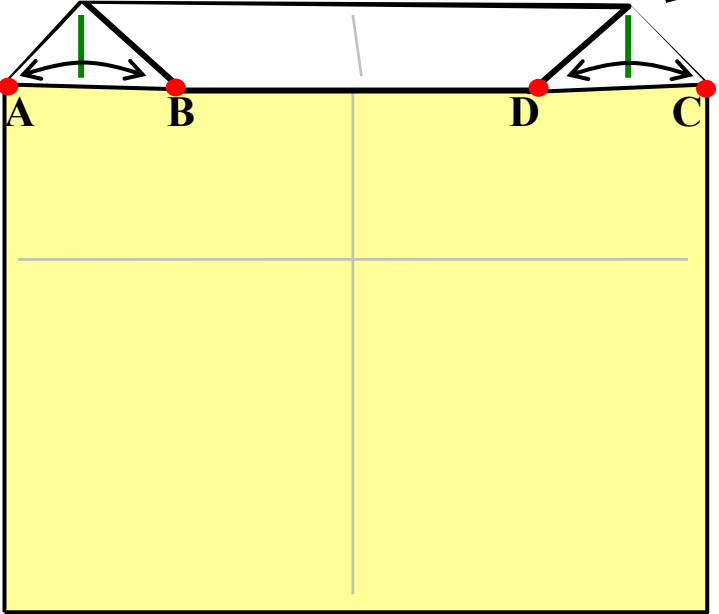
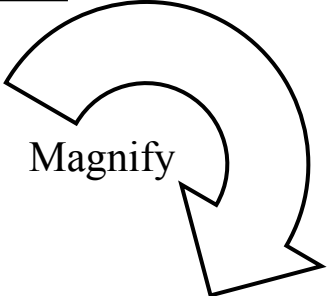
Using the previous crease as a guide, fold the corner flaps as shown.



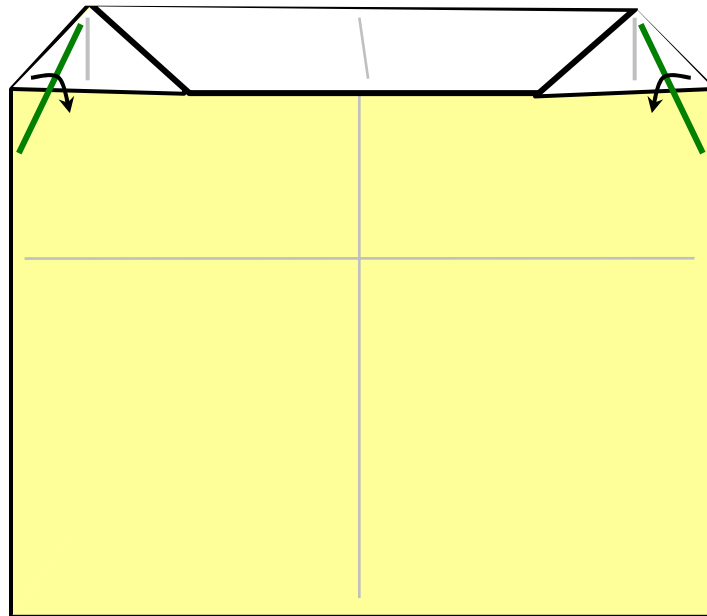
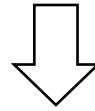
Fold the paper horizontally into one-fourths and then unfold.



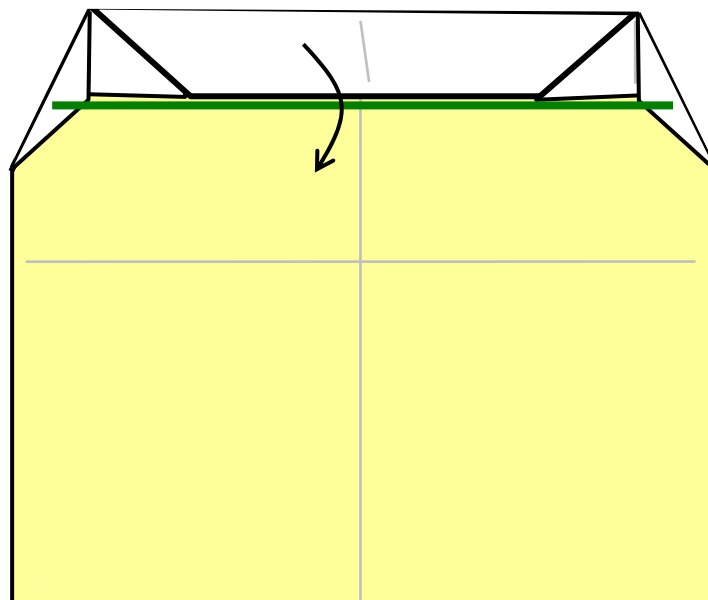
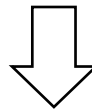
Fold down the top one-eighths



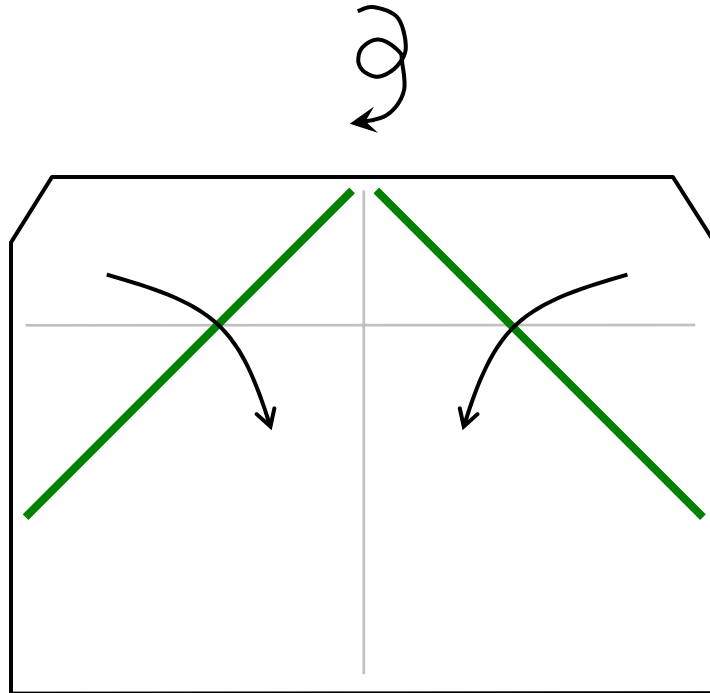
Make creases by folding points A to B and points C to D.



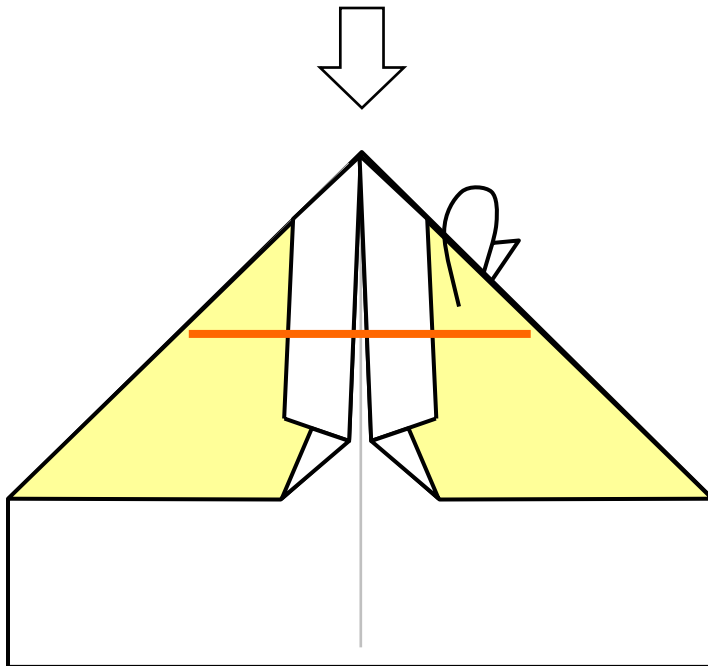
Fold along the bisectors as above, using the previous creases as a guide. Incidentally this is what gives the sharpness to the Sabre-sharp.



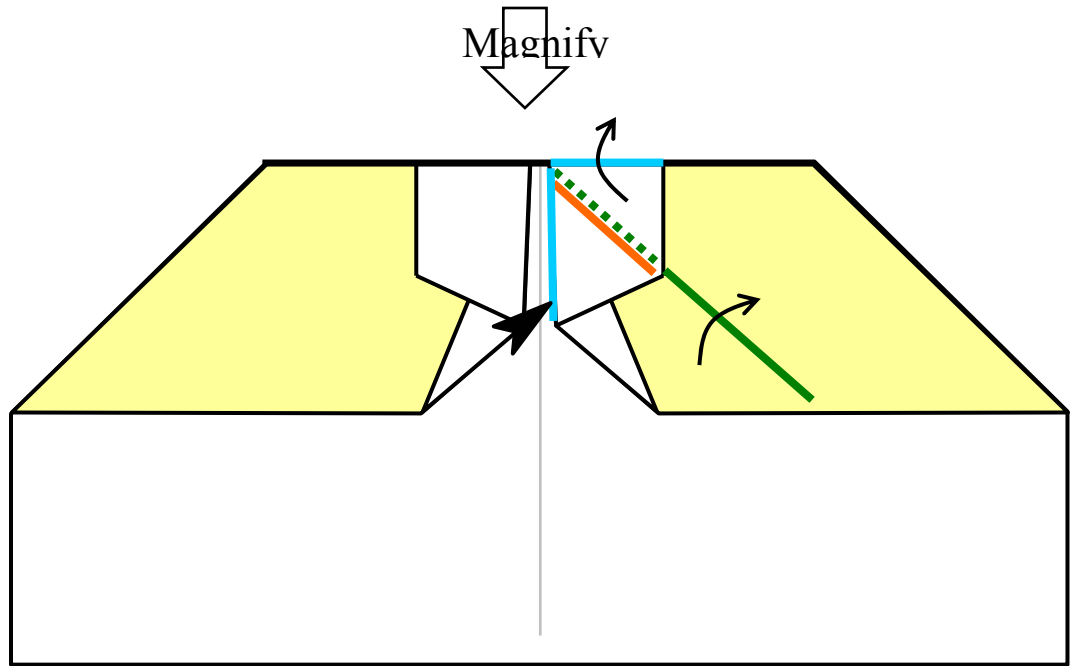
Fold the top one-fourths downward and then turn around the model



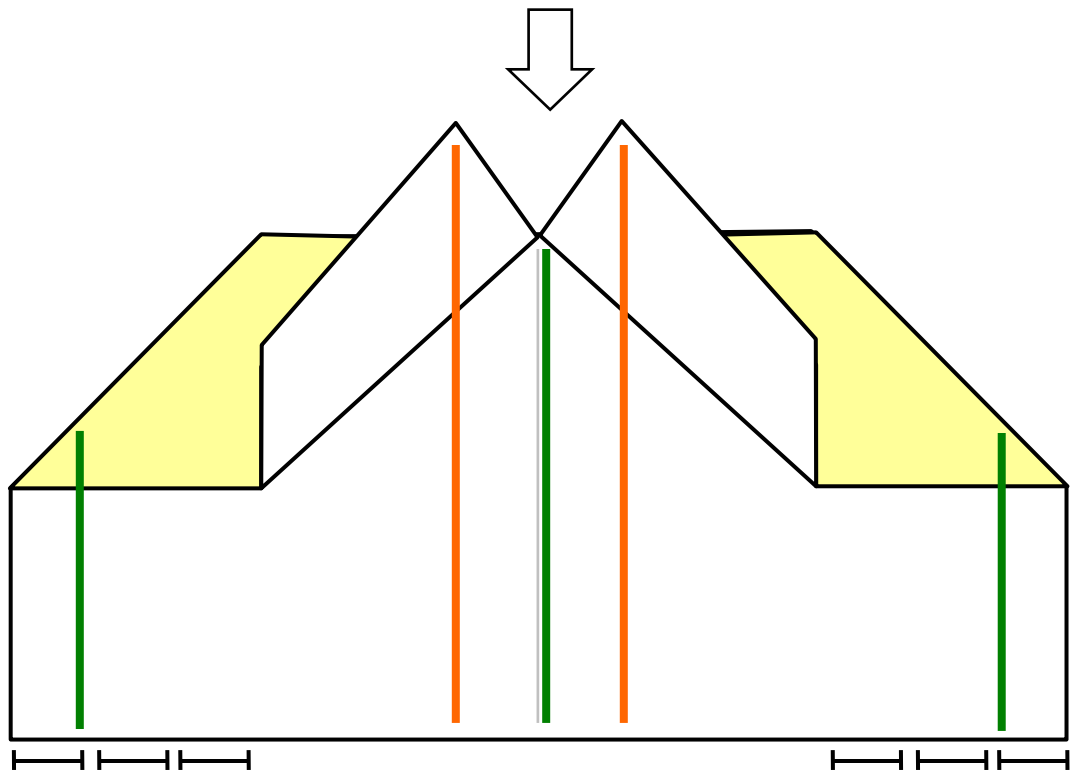
Fold towards the centre crease as shown.



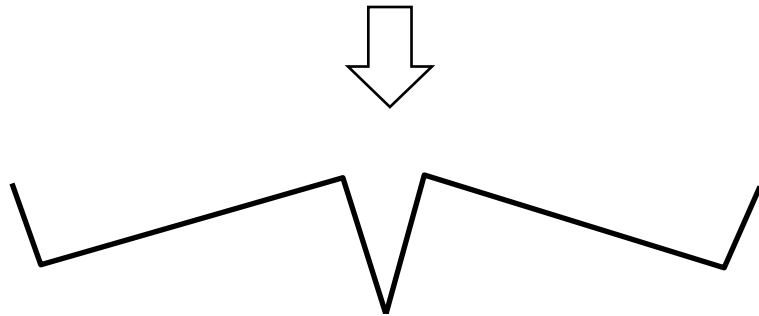
Mountain fold along the crease that was made in step two. i.e. fold half the triangle backward.



The tooth step
 Push along the solid black wedge, unfold along the blue lines.
 Notice the valley fold becoming dotted which means it is
 becoming hidden. Repeat for the left flap.



The round-up step
 Fold the wings from the pointed tips. Fold the winglets at $\frac{1}{3}^{\text{rd}}$
 of the yellow portion as shown.



Front View

Adjust the winglets and wings so that they look like the above figure when seen from front.
Now fly and have fun but take care not to poke others with the sharp tip.
